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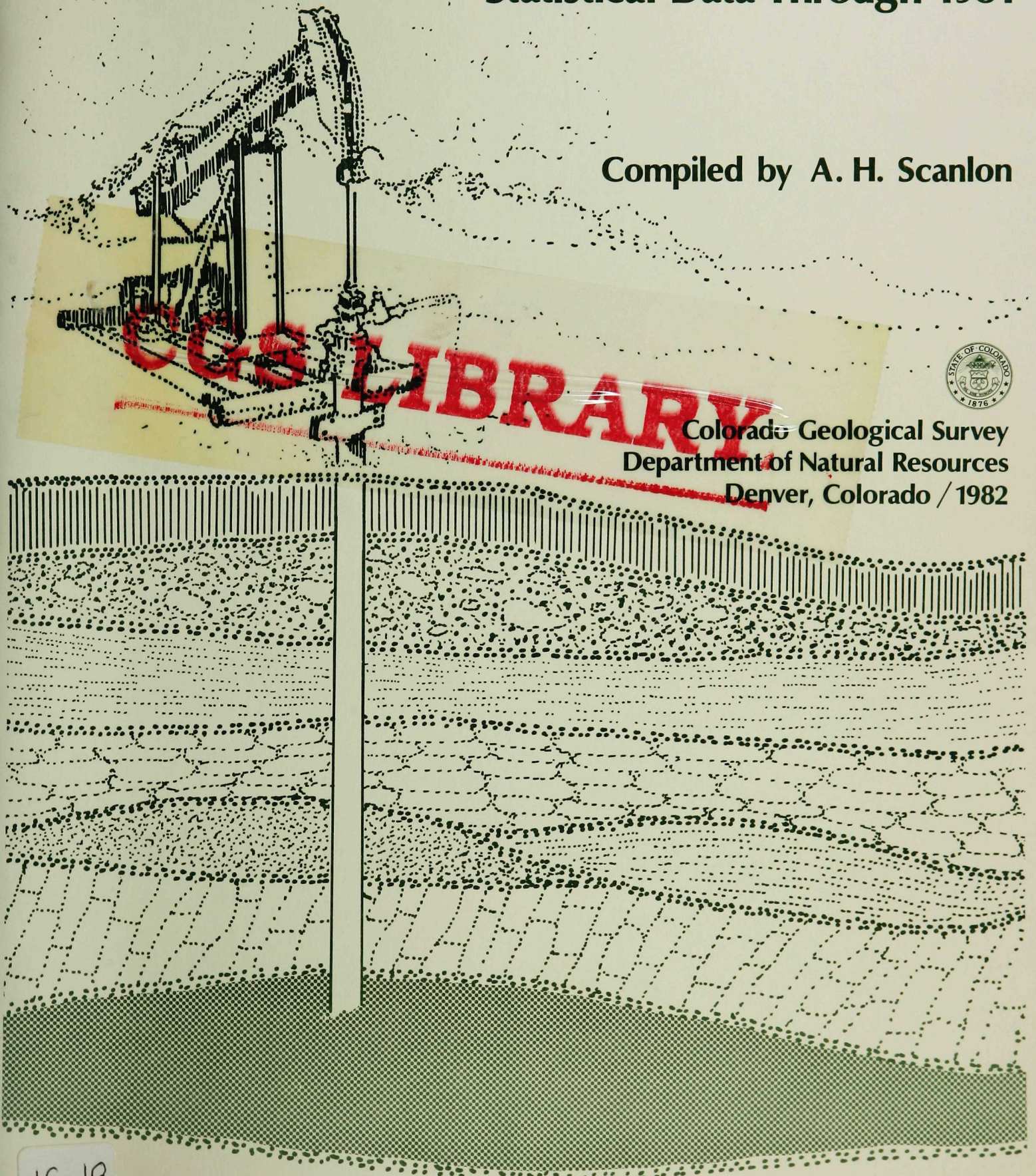

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Preface

Information Series 18 is presented as an update and revision of a previous Colorado Geological Survey publication, IS 3.

Statistical data contained in this publication are presented in columnar form and include all currently producing and abandoned oil and gas fields on record with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (CO & GCC). These data are listed in alphabetical order by county and by fields within each county (column 1). This column includes the year of discovery (and abandonment where applicable) and field classification (oil or gas). Field classification is based on a gas-oil ratio (GOR) of the fields's production. A GOR of greater than 15,000:1 is considered a gas field, whereas a GOR less than 15,000:1 is an oil field. In cases where there are several producing horizons, we have chosen the production from the most significant horizon for field classification. This classification is based on reported production and does not account for reserves or possible changes in field production. For fields located in two or more counties, a reference to the other county(ies) is given.

The field location (column 2) includes township and range. The number of wells producing or capable of producing are stated in column 3. Columns 4 and 5 indicate the producing formation and age, respectively. Production (columns 6, 7, 8) is listed individually for each horizon which produces within a specific field. Data can be easily used to obtain total production for the field. In cases where a field is located in two or more counties, a field total production line has been included in these columns. The field status data (column 9) shows how many wells are either producing (gas), flowing (oil), on artificial lift, shut-in, or abandoned. These are the classifications used by the CO & GCC. Additional details on production data by operator or lease within each field can be obtained from the CO & GCC annual publication entitled Oil & Gas Statistics. This publication is released at the end of each fiscal year.

To accompany this new publication, the Colorado Geological Survey is publishing Map Series 22, Colorado Oil and Gas Fields. This map, at a scale of 1:500,000, will display all oil and gas fields, active or abandoned, and includes producing horizons and their ages. In addition, the map will show pipelines, refineries, basin outlines, and other pertinent information. This map, along with IS #18, will afford a useful tool for both the public and private sector that needs current petroleum information.

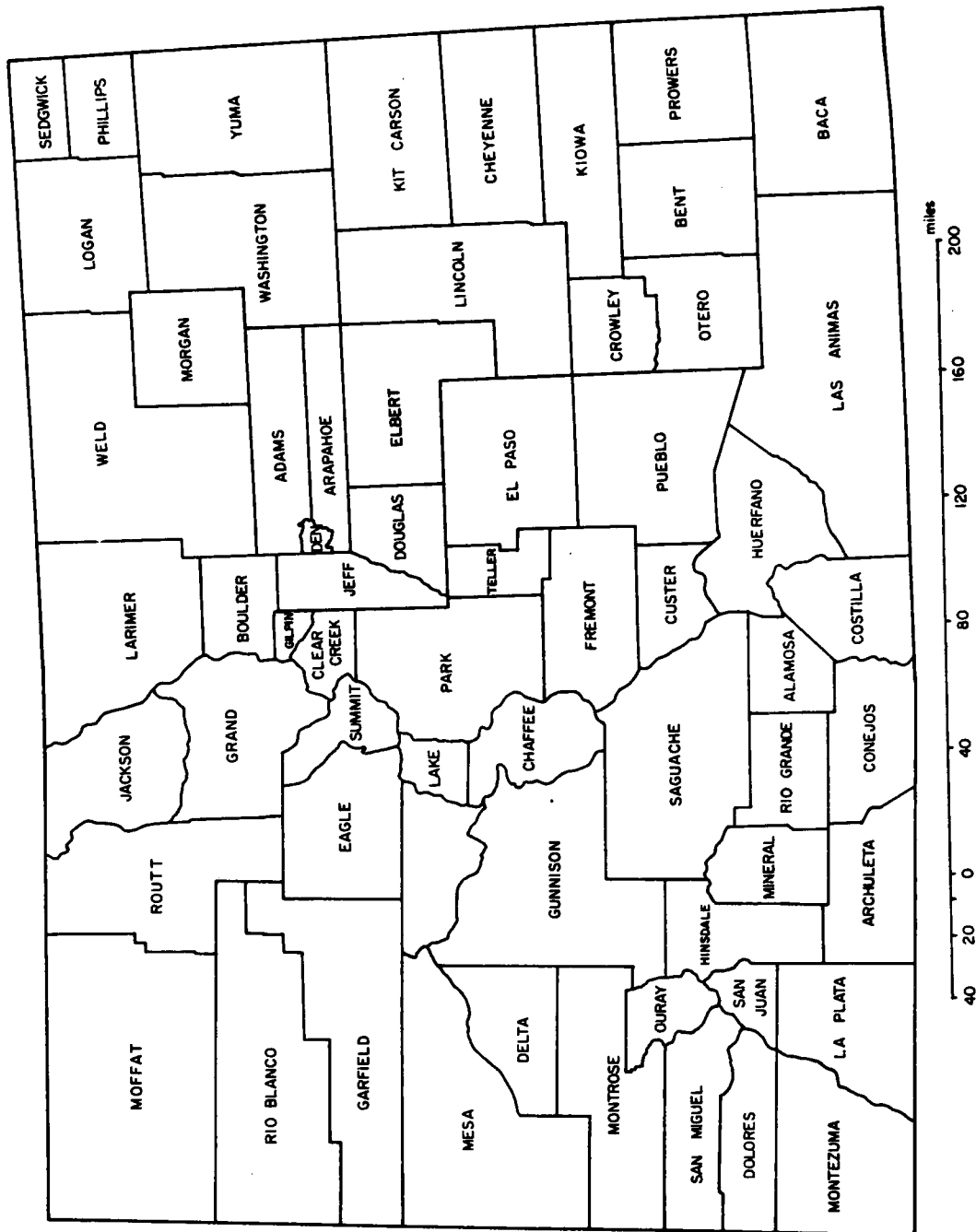


Figure 1. Colorado county map.

Oil & Gas Permits

In 1964 the COGCC began issuing oil and gas permits. These permits are issued in numerical consecutive order beginning each year with the year, then number one, two, three; i.e., for permits issued in 1981 the permits are 81-1, 81-2, 81-3, etc. The following lists the number of oil and gas permits approved for each year since this issuing began. In the case where a rework/reentry permit is approved for wells drilled prior to 1964, a permit number is assigned, being dated from the year when the rework/reentry permit is approved and not the year the well was initially drilled. For such permits for wells drilled after 1968, the initial permit year-number is used, and therefore is not considered as a new permit for the year this rework/reentry is approved.

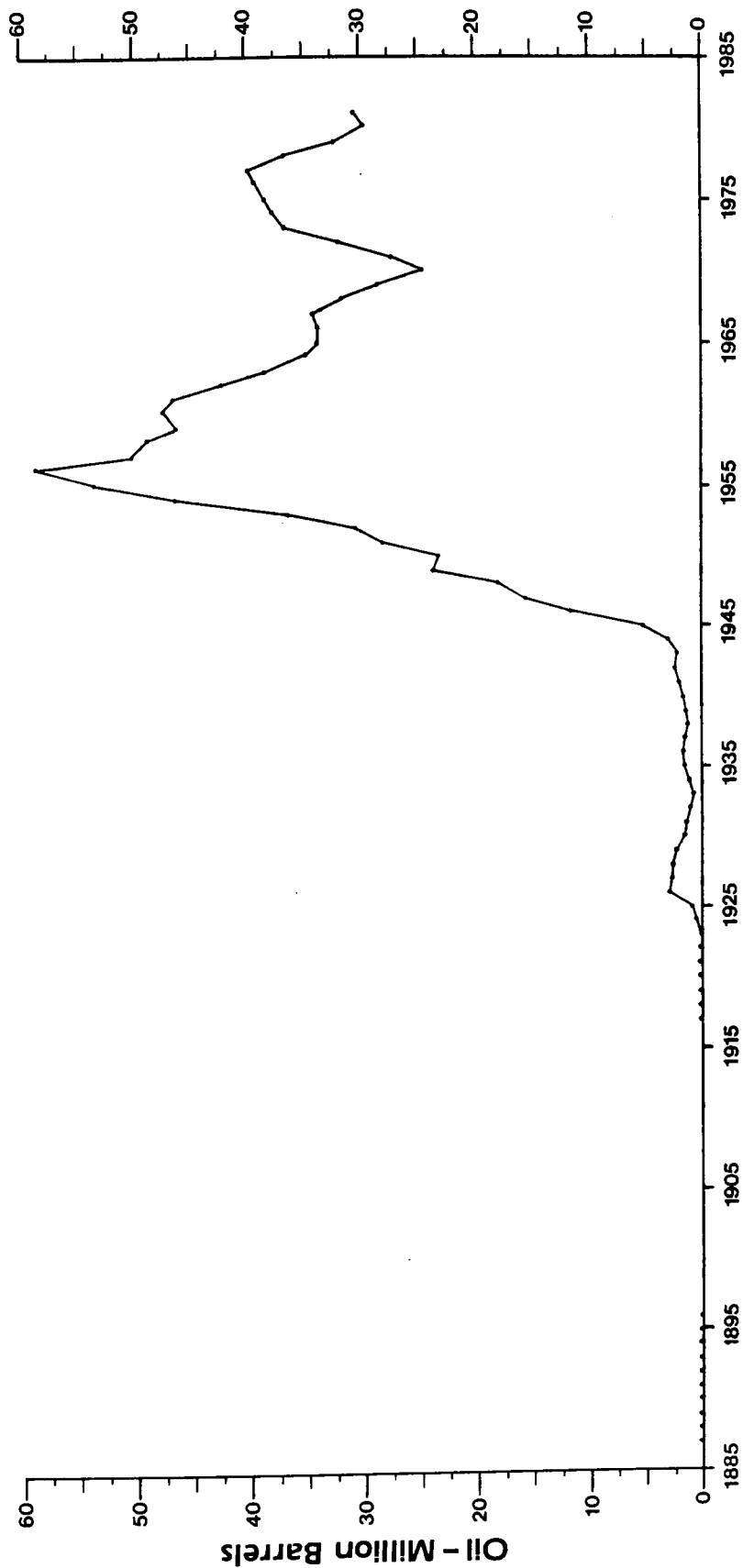


Figure 2. Trends in Colorado oil production.

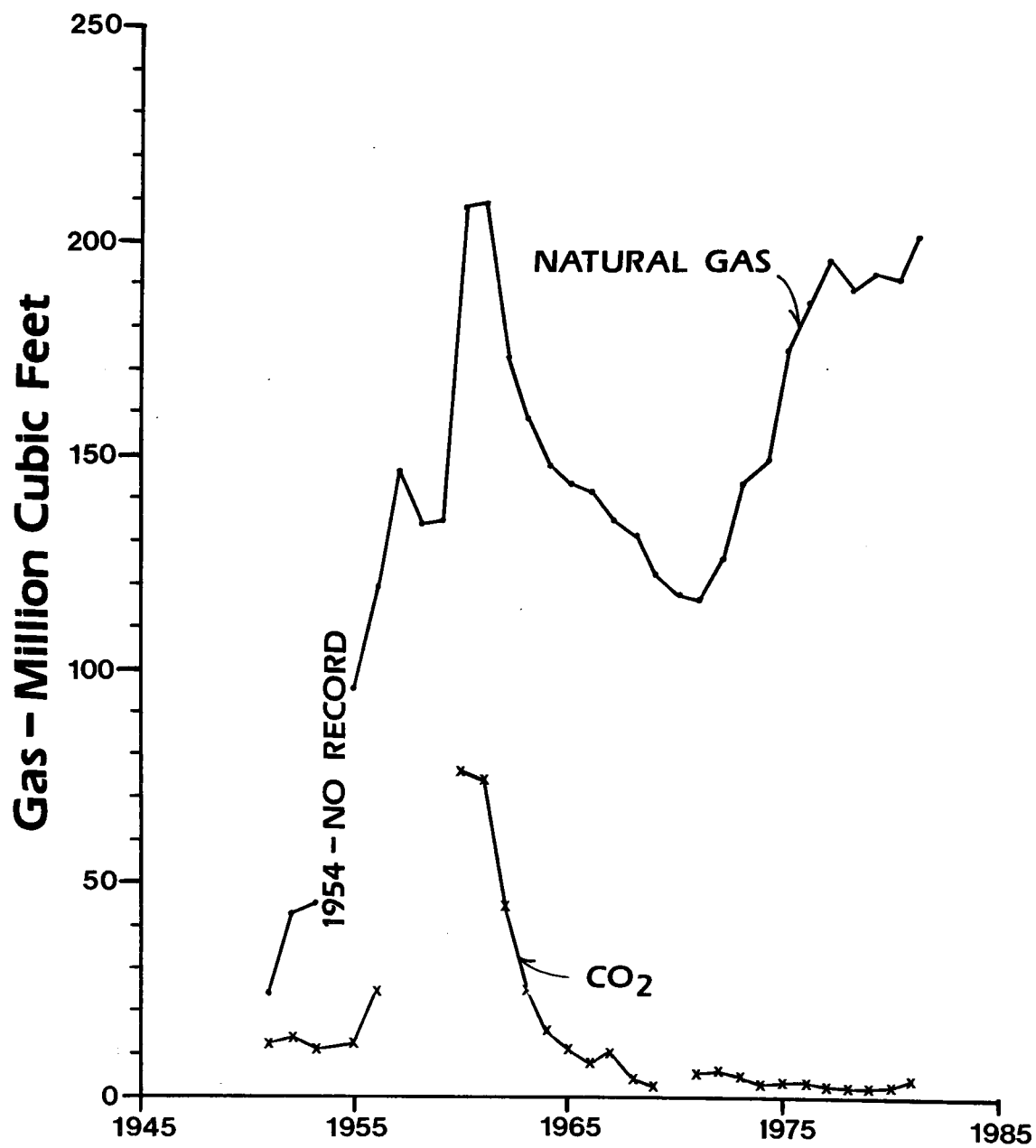


Figure 3. Trends in Colorado gas production.
