




2008 Pell Recipients

(resident undergraduates only)




2009 Percent Allocation of State Need Based Aid for Undergraduate Students by Institution






2008-2009 State and ARRA Support by Institution






















- •Demographic changes in the State's population will force change in Higher Education.
- •According to the State Demographers Office, underrepresented groups are all projected to grow at faster rates than the majority group, Whites.
- •By 2035, Minority groups will account for 32% of the statewide population, up from a quarter of the population in 2005.




• By 2035, Hispanics are projected to account for nearly a quarter of the Colorado population.




- •And Hispanics, in particular, are proportionally underrepresented in the State's public institutions of higher education
- •Given the population projections, institutions must develop aggressive recruitment and retention strategies to fulfill statewide education needs

Total Percent Enrollment Growth Since 1997 by Sector




- •Even though total enrollments show some groups remain underrepresented, it is in spite of the fact that the same groups grew rapidly over the last decade.
